

## **Child advocacy group gets \$1,000 grant**

SUMMERFIELD – Wal-Mart Supercenter presented a bonus grant of \$1,000 to the Lake-Sumter Children's Advocacy Center Friday.

Store Manager Tracy Skeen presented the check to LSCAC Board President Paula Stinson.

The LSCAC investigates and helps in the prosecution of child-abuse allegations, provides forensic medical exams and fosters a team effort among the state Department of Children and Families, local law enforcement and other government agencies. The grant money is to be used specifically to replenish LSCAC supplies of child-appropriate books on physical and sexual abuse, such as coloring books and educational or therapeutic stories, which are used in crisis counseling with children.
